



Board of Directors Self-nomination Form

The Association of Shelter Veterinarians (ASV) seeks nominations for its Board of Directors. Directors are elected at the ASV annual meeting, which occurs at the annual American Board of Veterinary Practitioners (ABVP) Symposium each October. Terms are for 3 years, starting in January. Directors are eligible for re-election once for a second three-year term. Board members are asked to participate in conference calls and Board emails throughout the year, participate in one in-person Board meeting and the ASV General Membership meeting (these in-person meetings take place at the ABVP Symposium - travel is not provided), and contribute to committees and projects to advance the work of ASV. We hope you will consider joining us!

Eligibility: Veterinarians who have been ASV members for at least 2 years are eligible to be nominated. Previous two-term board members are eligible to be nominated again after a period of not less than one year off the Board.

Election Criteria: The ASV nominations committee will recommend a slate of nominees for a vote by the current Board of Directors. Nominees' participation in ASV committee work, attendance at annual meetings, and demonstration of leadership and advocacy will be considered. Additional consideration will be given to skills that nominees may possess that would benefit the ASV, such as financial planning, fundraising, or legal expertise. In an effort to maintain balanced representation of geographic regions and professional areas of shelter medicine (e.g. animal shelters, spay/neuter clinics, public health agencies, national humane organizations, academia), the nominations committee will also consider these aspects when recommending nominees.

Nomination requirements: All potential board members should apply via self-nomination. Nomination packages must be submitted by e-mail to info@shelternets.org. The deadline for submission is July 1. Each nomination package must include the items listed below.

- Completed nomination form
- Letter of intent
- Curriculum vitae or resume (not to exceed 3 pages)

In addition, letters of recommendation or a list of references may be included at the discretion of the applicant.
