



## Meritorious Service Award Nomination Form

This award recognizes remarkable members of the Association of Shelter Veterinarians who have made significant contributions to the advancement of shelter veterinary medicine via leadership, public service, research, education, advocacy, and/or clinical practice. The intent of this award is to bring attention to excellence in shelter medicine by recognizing those who serve as exceptional ambassadors of the profession. The award designee will receive a plaque, a shelter medicine textbook of their choice, and a \$250 donation to an organization of their choice. The recipient will be honored at the ASV Annual Meeting, held in conjunction with the annual American Board of Veterinary Practitioners (ABVP) Symposium in October. Funding is available to help cover the recipient's travel expenses.

**Eligibility:** Veterinarians, veterinary students, and affiliate ASV members are eligible; current ASV Board Members are ineligible.

**Nomination requirements:** Anyone may nominate eligible, qualified ASV members. Self-nominations are not accepted. Each nomination package must include the items listed below. Additional materials will not be accepted.

- Completed nomination form
- Letter summarizing nominee's professional background and stating his/her qualifications for the award
- Nominee's curriculum vitae or resume (not to exceed 3 pages)
